SWIM LESSON POLICIES AND WAIVER

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.

THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

I, the undersigned participant or parent/guardian agrees and understands that swimming is a HAZARDOUS activity and request voluntary participation for myself/ my minor(s) to participate in the Central-Clemson Recreation Center (CCRC) Swim program/events, which are hereinafter referred to as the “activities”.

I consent to my/my minor(s) participation in the activities and acknowledge that the minor(s) and I fully understand my/my minor(s) participation may involve risk of serious injury or death, including losses which may result not only from my/my minor(s) own actions, inactions or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the condition of the facilities, equipment, or areas where the program/event or activity is being conducted, and/or the rules of play of this type of event or activity. I understand that if I have any risk concerns, I should discuss the risks associated with my participation with the activity coordinators/event staff before I sign this document and before any activities begin.

Release – Parents’/Guardians’ Rights:

In consideration of the right to use the CCRC and/or to participate in CCRC programs, I hereby release the CCRC, Town of Central, City of Clemson and its officers, agents, employees, and representatives from any and all liability for injuries or damages, present or future, resulting from my participation in any activity or use of any equipment. I/We understand and agree that this release and waiver includes any claims based on actions, omissions, or alleged negligence, gross or otherwise, of the City of Clemson, and/or their elected officials, employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, invitees, guests, participants, contractors, and referees/umpires.

I hereby indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties, of and from, and do discharge and waive, any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, and liabilities that I may have or sustain with respect to any and all damage and/or injury, of any type, arising from Minor Participant(s) participation in the activities. I also agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

I certify that I/my minor(s) am/is in good health and have no physical or other condition that would prevent participation in this activity.

I authorize any representative of the CCRC Swim program/events to have the participant/myself treated in any medical emergency during participation of said activities. Furthermore, I agree to use my/minor(s) personal medical insurance as a primary medical coverage payment if accident or injury occurs.

SWIM LESSON POLICIES AND WAIVER

INDIVIDUAL SWIM LESSON SPECIFIC POLICIES

1. Absolutely NO refunds will be given for any reason
2. In the case of inclement weather the following conditions will apply
 - If at least twenty minutes of in-water instruction is provided the remainder of the lesson will consist of dry land safety instruction and will count as a full lesson.
 - If less than twenty minutes of in-water instruction is provided there will be one make up lesson due to inclement weather.
 - Lessons cancelled by the facility will be credited back to the account for future use.
1. Lessons are non-transferable to other individuals.
2. Member rates only apply to children within your household AND on your membership.
3. Classes will not be extended for late arrivals.
4. The CCRC does not guarantee that the same instructor will be teaching each lesson.

The following guidelines have been put in place for the safety of your children and our lifeguards. We sincerely ask that you assist us in providing the best experience for your children by following these rules. These rules have been implemented to help your children maintain focus on their instructors and improve their ability to swim. These lessons are meant to be fun for children and to ensure that they are fun and most importantly educational; we ask everyone to adhere to these guidelines.

1. Please arrive 5 minutes prior to swim lesson, dressed in appropriate swimwear.
2. Please take care of any bathroom breaks before the lesson so as to not disturb the lessons.
3. Parents may sit in the pool area, or in the facility lobby area.
4. In the event of inclement weather the Central-Clemson Recreation Center will provide 1 make up lesson, due to closure of the pool for lightning and/or thunder.
5. Parents must remain on the premises during the lesson.
6. A child in swim lessons does not grant you access to the facility, or the ability to swim prior to or after your designated swim lesson time. But, memberships are available. Memberships will also give you a discount on swim lessons.

Cancellation Policy

We recognize that unexpected events occasionally occur in everyone's life. To ensure fairness and efficiency for all clients and staff, the following policies are observed:

Each client is permitted one complimentary cancellation or no-show. The policies outlined below will apply to any subsequent cancellations, no-shows, or late arrivals.

1. Cancellations:

- A 24-hour advance notice is required to cancel a lesson.
- Cancellations made with less than 24 hours' notice will incur a fee, used to compensate the instructor for lost time and earnings. This fee must be paid before your next scheduled lesson.
 - 30 Minute Lesson Fee: \$7.50
 - 1 Hour Lesson Fee: \$15.00

2. No-Shows:

- Failing to attend a scheduled lesson without any prior notification is considered a no-show.
- No-shows will be charged the full cost of the missed lesson.

3. Late Arrivals:

- If you arrive late, your lesson may be shortened to avoid disrupting the instructor's schedule and the appointments of other clients.
- The instructor will determine if there is sufficient time remaining to start a lesson, depending on the severity of the delay.
- Regardless of the actual length of the lesson given, you are responsible for the full lesson fee.
- Please plan to arrive on time out of respect for your instructor and fellow clients.
